

# Washington High School Wellness Program SERVICE SUMMARY OF 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

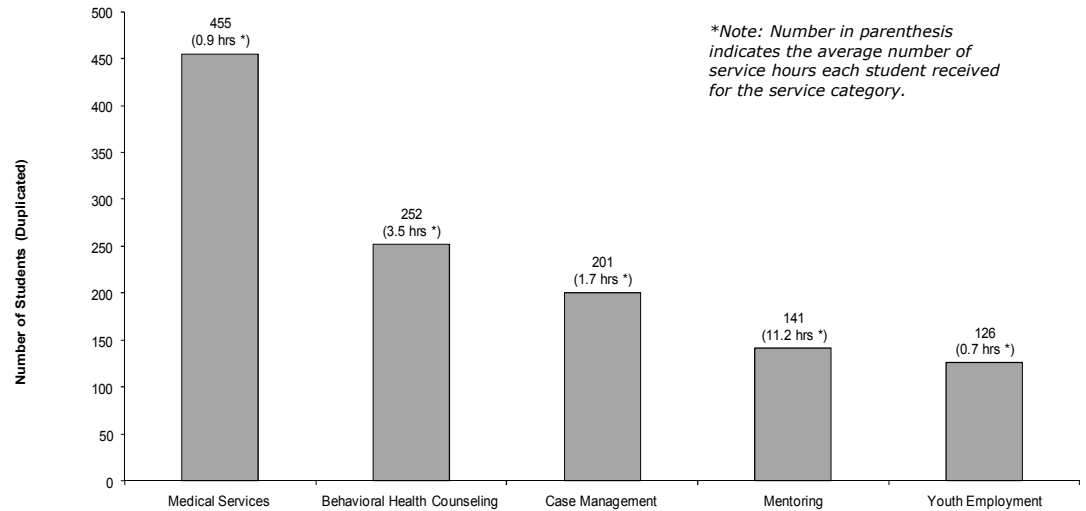


<b>Total Number of Youth Served</b>	<b>792 [Non-Duplicated]</b> 37% of 842 (the student population of Washington in 11-12)
<b>Total Number of Service Hours Provided</b>	3,551 (an average of 4.48 hours per student)

## TYPES OF SERVICE

- The top three most accessed services were *medical services* (57% of all youth served), *behavioral health counseling* (32%), and *case management* (25%). The top five service categories are shown in Chart 1.
- The most time intensive service provided was *youth leadership development*, where youth received an average of 12.6 hours of service through the Youth Outreach Program (not pictured in Chart 1).

## PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHICS

- Demographic data on the racial/ethnic groups served are presented in Chart 2. Chinese students made up 40% of the students served, Other Non-White students made up 16% of the students served, and Latino students made up 15% of the students served.
- The Wellness Program served more female students than male students (Chart 3).

Chart 2: Comparison of Student Race/Ethnicity in School and Wellness Program Population

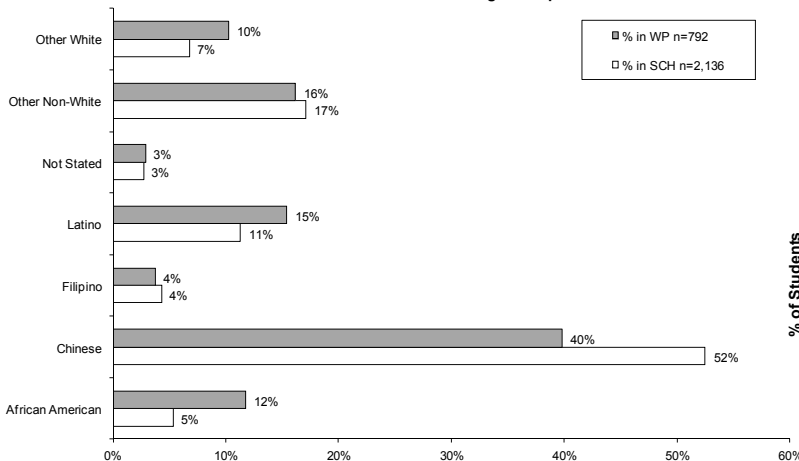


Chart 3: Comparison of Student Gender in School and Wellness Program Populations
